CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COLLINGWOOD

BY-LAW NO. 2712

AN AMENDING BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COLLINGWOOD TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 2710 TO REGULATE BICYCLES

WHEREAS it is considered desirable and expedient to pass a by-law to amend By-law Number 2710 of the Town of Collingwood providing for the regulation of bicycles to provide a definition of the term "bicycle."

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COLLING-WOOD ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- Paragraph numbered one (1) of the said By-law
 Numbered 2710 is hereby repealed and the following paragraph substituted:
 - "1(a) This by-law may be cited as The Bicycle By-law.
 - (b) "Bicycle" shall mean a two wheeled vehicle with at least one wheel having a diameter of more than eighteen (18) inches."
- 2. All other parts of By-law Numbered 2710 are hereby confirmed as originally enacted.
- This by-law shall come into force and have effect from and after the passing thereof.

READ a first and second time, considered in the Committee of the Whole, read a third time and finally passed this 24th day of November, 1970.
